Since then I've signed a publishing and record deal, recorded an album and 2 EP's, played all around the world (including tours with Rag 'n' Bone Man and becaming Jo Whiley's 'Favourite Thing'). I've written and worked with many artists, producers, students and teachers of all ages. I moved to West Wales in 2020 to write, teach and live more simply.
